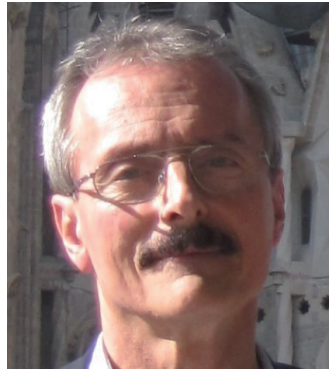

Modern History of South East Asia-E2

Finding One's Voice-E2: A course in Film, Philosophy, and Education

Films can entertain, but can they also educate? Some films can leave us excited or moved by what we have seen. They can make us puzzle and argue over the events in the story. They can make us see the world in a different way. Like good novels, they can lead us to reflect on experience. The techniques of film-making (camera-work, editing, set-design, costume, music, etc.) can draw attention to human behavior and expression in unique ways. They can lead us to think in new ways.

This three-day intensive course involves the viewing of two classic films, Stella Dallas (1937) and Kokoro (1953). These are concerned, respectively, with a young woman and with a young man who are trying to make sense of the world, to understand themselves, and to find their own ways of expression. We shall view the films together and follow this with careful analysis of particular scenes. This involves the exercise of aesthetic judgement, in which the expression and comparison of individual responses to shared experience is of central importance. To do this in relation to the kinds of questions that the films raise – about truth, self-discovery, and what matters in life – is a philosophical exercise in education.

CyberPsychology-E2

This is a two-week intensive lecture course on Cyberpsychology. Traditional lectures will be supplemented by in-class activities, discussion and reading, and outside-of-class activities, library searches and reading. It will cover experimental and social approaches to the understanding of how individuals behave within online environments, and how cyberspace moulds psychological behaviours and traits. The focus will be on cognitive and psychometric approaches, but will include discussion of topics within social psychology including cyberbullying. The course will cover key contemporary aspects of cyberpsychology, with activities and discussions about current affairs and real-world examples that exemplify psychological influences online.

Understanding World Politics-E2

Following the media only creates a dramatic understanding of international political phenomena, usually of the sort where greater and lesser nationally leading personae scheme with each other. This kind of understanding is surprisingly prevalent even among university students. The course is organized to give sound theoretical tools for understanding the basic structural and processual phenomena of world politics, of the games played by great, middle and small powers, and what is the role of communication and diplomatic protocol in the day to day actions of states. The course is strictly theory based, but with long teaching experience it has been made understandable to beginners of all disciplines. It does not require previous studies of world politics/international relations, but it has something to give also for students specializing on those subjects.

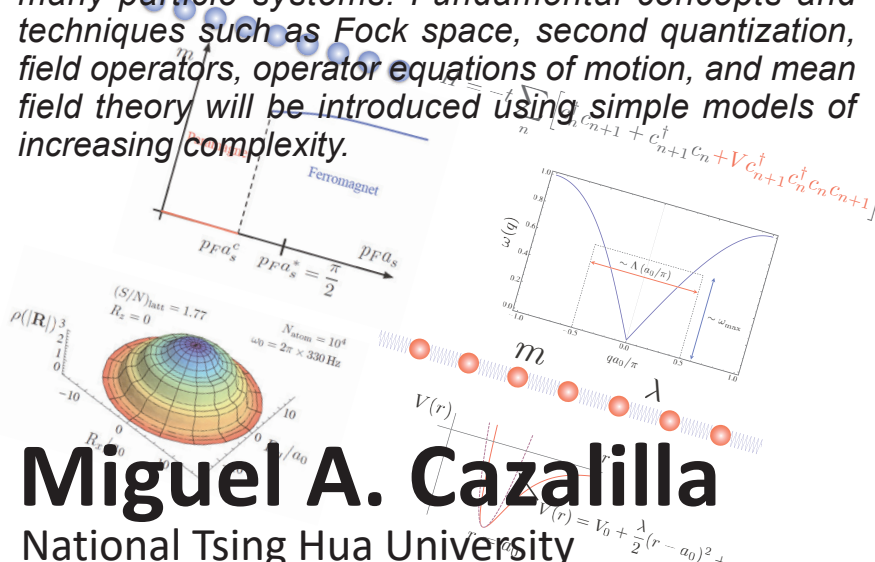
