【授業の概要・目的】												
<p>The goal of Test-Taking I is to improve learner ’ s proficiency in Academic English through guided practice in tasks designed to raise learner awareness of the TOEFL iBT test. The course will cover items representative of the four test components: speaking, reading, listening, and writing.</p> <p>本授業の目的は、TOEFL iBTに対する学習者の意識を高めるためにデザインされたタスクのガイド付き練習を通して、アカデミック英語の習熟度を向上させることである。このコースでは、スピーキング、リーディング、リスニング、ライティングの4技能を扱う。</p>												
【到達目標】												
<p>In this course, students engage with learning materials designed to develop test-taking strategies for TOEFL iBT questions. In-class activities focus on developing learner awareness and test-taking ability across the four parts of this widely used proficiency test: reading, listening, speaking and writing. Homework includes completing practice tests and preparing for class by reading portions of the assigned textbook. An attempt will be made to balance the four components of the TOEFL iBT so that learners can develop their English language proficiency at the skill level.</p>
