Notes: (1)Participants are expected to attend the whole program actively, including at least 8 out of 12 Academic Lectures.

#### [Number of Students]

A maximum of 2 outstanding students from partner universities worldwide will be accepted for this program. We are seeking students from a wide range of majors and therefore accept applications from students from any department.

# [Eligibility requirements]

- Applicants must be students from (a). universities that hold academic cooperation partnerships (MOU)\* or student exchange agreement (SEA)\*\* with Kyoto University; AND (b). universities that have NOT been allocated a special quota for this year's program by Kyoto University\*\*\*.

## [Preferable candidates]

- · Students who have never been to Japan
- Students who have never studied Japanese language
- · Students whose major is not Japanese or Japanese studies
- · Undergraduate students
- Preference will be given to students who are permanent residents or citizens of the country where the partner university is located, but international students studying in the partner university may also apply.

# [Application Procedures]

(1) Prior Confirmation

Students who wish to participate the program should make prior confirmation via the following form:

The Program office will check the student's eligibility and contact the student with further instructions, including the URL for the application system. Deadline for prior confirmation is **JST 12:00pm (noon)**, **May 25 (Thu)**, **2023**.

#### (2) Application System

All application will be done through an online application system. The URL will be disclosed to the students directly from the Program office.

#### (3) Recommendation Letter

In the online application system, students are required to nominate a supervising professor to provide a letter of recommendation.

Once applicants submit their applications, an e-mail notification will be automatically sent to the recommender with instructions on how to submit a letter of recommendation. Students must notify the recommender and receive the recommender's consent before the application. Students must also be careful to submit their applications allowing sufficient time for the recommender to submit the letter of recommendation.

The person writing the recommendation should be one of the following:

- 1. Academic advisor, supervisor at the partner university
- 2. The head of selection committee
- 3. The head of the organization responsible for this program at the partner university (e.g., Director of International Affairs) \*
- 4. Others: Please contact us.
- (\*) In the case of KCJS and SJC, this means the Director of KCJS and SJC.

The letter of recommendation is also due JST 12:00 pm (noon), June 2, 2023.

#### (4) Uploading files

Students will be required to upload the following files.

- -Photo taken within 6 months
- -Passport copy or student ID copy
- -Official academic transcript of your university
- -English test score (optional)
- -A "cover-letter" video (3minutes long including self-introduction and reasons for you to apply for this program)

#### (5) Selection

If necessary, selection will be made by the Program office. Students will be notified of the selection results by **June 5 (Mon)**. Final notification of acceptance into the program will be sent after confirmation of the payment of the participation fee.

#### [Tuition Fees]

#### JPY 47,000.

The method of payment: Bank transfer in Japanese yen only (transfer fee to be borne by the participants). Further details will be notified individually along with the notification of selection results.

# [Personal expense]

The following personal expenses are to be borne by the participants:

Visa application fee / Mandatory travel insurance / Airfare / Actual cost of field trip and cultural experience/ Accommodation fee and other personal costs

#### [Designated Accommodation]

Participants are required to stay at the designated accommodation facility below throughout the program period. Reservations will be made by Kyoto University.
