Call for Applications (Individual Application) "Kyoto Summer Program" at Kyoto University, July 29- August 10, 2022 Kyoto University Asian Studies Unit (KUASU) Track

Dear students at partner universities,

We are currently accepting applications for the "2022 Kyoto Summer Program" at Kyoto University. In the program, participants will benefit from not only the scholarly excellence at Kyoto University, but also close interactions with a range of students from various countries, including local students.

The program is traditionally held in Kyoto. However, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the 2022 program will be held online during July 29 - August 10, 2022 (A preparatory session will be held on July 28 (attendance required)).

*On July 28, participants should attend one of the briefing sessions to check their internet condition. The details will be announced later.



[Program Schedule]

This year's program will be provided in two shifts (A and B) for the convenience of participants joining online from different time zones.

Both shifts consist of an orientation, Kyoto University introduction, Japanese language classes, cultural experience, discussion session, final presentation and completion ceremony. Participants will be assigned to one of the shifts by Kyoto University, taking into account the time difference and other factors. For Academic lectures, participants will be asked to choose at least 5 out of 11 lectures, which are not provided in shifts.

*Please be aware that Japanese language class schedules may be partially changed to "Makeup Japanese language classes may be offered" on the above timetable.

[Shift]

Due to course content, students applying for KUASU track must join Shift A.

- Notes: (1) If any participant would like to attend another shift, please consult with the Program office.
 - (2)Participants need to be able to attend **80%** of the whole program **on a real time basis.**
 - (3) As it is mentioned in (1), in principle, participants should attend lectures online in real time. For those who are unable to attend in real time due to unavoidable reasons, such as a conflict with regular classes at the participant's home university, we are planning to provide materials of real time lectures (such as handouts, lecture slides, and/or recordings of live sessions). Students must inform us in advance if they will be unable to attend in real time.
 - (4) The registration form for academic lectures will be distributed in June.

[Number of Students]

A maximum of **10** outstanding students (ILAS and KUASU in total) from partner universities worldwide will be accepted for this program. We are seeking students from a wide range of majors and therefore accept applications from students from any department.

[Eligibility Requirements]

• Applicants must be students from (a). universities that hold academic cooperation partnerships (MOU)* or student exchange agreement (SEA)** with Kyoto University; AND (b). universities that have NOT been allocated a special quota for this year's program by Kyoto University***.

• Students who have experience taking Japan-related classes (Japanese studies, Japanese literature, Japanese history, Japanese language etc.) (N3 or higher level of Japanese is preferred)

• Students enrolled in an undergraduate or master's program

• Preference will be given to students who are permanent residents or citizens of the country where the partner university is located, but international students studying in the partner university may also apply.

[Application Procedures]

(1) Prior Confirmation

Students who wish to participate the program should make prior confirmation via the following form:

The Program office will check the student's eligibility and contact the student with further instructions, including the URL for the application system. Deadline for prior confirmation is **JST 12:00pm (noon)**, **June 8, 2022**.

(2) Application System

All application will be done through an online application system. The URL will be disclosed to the students directly from the Program office.

(3) Recommendation Letter

In the online application system, students are required to nominate a supervising professor to provide a letter of recommendation.

Once students submit their applications, an e-mail notification will be automatically sent to the recommender with instructions on how to submit a letter of recommendation. Students must notify the recommender and receive the recommender's consent before the application. Students must also be careful to submit their applications allowing sufficient time for the recommender to submit the letter of recommendation. The letter of recommendation is also due JST 12:00 pm(noon), June 13, 2022.

(4) Uploading files

Students will be required to upload the following files.

-Academic Transcript (in English)

-A copy of the passport photo page

(Students who do not have a passport may substitute with student ID card copy)

-One photo of 3cm (W) x 3.4cm (H)

(5) Selection

If necessary, selection will be made by the Program office. Students will be notified of the selection results by **June 16.** Final notification of acceptance into the program will be sent after confirmation of the payment of the participation fees.

(6) Request Admission

Once selected, students applying for KUASU track must fill in the "Request Admission" form (attached below) and acquire the signature of either (a) the dean of the faculty they belong to or (b) the director of the department in charge of student exchange programs.* Deadline for submission of "Request Admission" form is **JST 11:59pm, June 30, 2022**.

*To help students prepare the "Request Admission" form, the Kyoto Summer Program office will inform the partner universities regarding the form in advance and/or offer any assistance needed on request from students. However, students should bear in mind that the final responsibility in preparing the "Request Admission" form is on the student's side.

[Fees]

◇ JPY 42,000.

◇The method of payment: Bank transfer in Japanese yen only (transfer fee to be borne by the participants). Further details will be notified individually along with the notification of selection results.
◇ Participants need to prepare their own internet access and a device such as a personal computer, a tablet, or a smartphone for participating in online classes. We recommend using a personal computer with a camera, microphone, and a speaker.
