<b>[Overview and purpose of the course]</b>							
<p>The course is proposed for already advanced students. It will be given in French only and requires a good level.</p> <p>It gives a preparation to DELF and DALF diplomas (exams organized by the French Ministry of Education to certify linguistic skills).</p> <p>The class will focus on the preparation of exercices of DELF B2 and DALF C1, exams that are required to enter famous selective schools and universities in France.</p> <p>Through many documents about French culture and contemporary society, we will develop the capacities to debate and analyse graphs and opinions, to describe a scene and to express a point of view. Grammar and vocabulary will be used on thematic sessions.</p>							
<b>[Course objectives]</b>							
<p>-to improve one's reading, writing, and oral skills</p> <p>-to prepare DELF, the proficiency exam designed by the French Ministry of Education.</p> <p>-to analyze and sum up a document, to debate and express an opinion, to understand a radio talk.</p>							
<b>[Course schedule and contents)]</b>							
<p>After an introductory lecture (week 1) presenting the goals and exercises of the class, during the remaining weeks 2 to 14, we will train on various exercises, fitting the schemes of the exam : oral and written comprehension, oral and written production.</p> <p>The class will be held in French and requires an advanced level.</p> <p>We shall see new themes, words and structures, different from the ones of the first semester.</p>							
<b>[Course requirements]</b>

<b>[Evaluation methods and policy]</b>							
There shall be an intermediary test and, at the end of the semester, a final DELF test. However, the global grade will be given in consideration not only of these tests but also of the attendance and activity during the whole semester.
