[Overview and purpose of the course]

文献から、限られた時間内に必要な情報を得るためには、1)その分野で頻出する専門用語が理解で きること、2)文献の中で何がどこに書かれているかを見極めることが求められるであろう。また、 より深く的確に文献の内容を理解するためには、その分野あるいは近隣分野の文献により多く触れ る経験を積むことも重要である。この授業では、主に1)に着目し、その能力の獲得を企図しながら、 文献を読み進めていく。そして、自立性を持って文献講読の計画を立て、遂行する力を養っていく。

To gain information from academic articles and documents in a limited time, we need to have the following reading techniques: 1) to understand technical terms of the particular field, and 2) to comprehend what is written and where it is written in the texts. In addition, to understand the content of the reading, students need enough experiences of having read materials in the field.

In this class, students will improve their academic reading skills through studying and discussions of journal articles in their fields of interest while focusing on technique 1) above. Students will also develop the ability to make their own reading list and use it throughout the semester.
