### [Overview and purpose of the course]

受講生は人文科学分野の文章を読み進め、学術的な関心・理解を深めるのに必要な日本語運用能力を向上させる。また、読みとった内容について、専門用語を用いながら、読み手を意識した文章にまとめる。本授業では、主に人文科学分野に共通した表現・語彙を含む文章を扱い、後期に提供される日本語上級(文献講読IIIB)でのより専門性の高い文献を読み解く基礎を養成する。

Students will read texts in the field of humanities and improve their Japanese language skills necessary to develop their academic interest and understanding. They will also summarize what they have read, using technical terms, with the reader in mind. This class mainly deals with texts containing expressions and vocabulary common to the field of humanities, and fosters the foundation for reading and understanding more specialized literature in the Advanced Japanese (Academic Reading IIIB) course offered in the second semester.

## [Course objectives]

- (1)専門の学習・研究に役立つ、より高度な日本語応用力を向上させる。
- (2)不自由なく大学の講義が理解でき、学術的な文章の読み書きや議論ができる。
- (3)文法的な誤りが少なく、場面に応じた言い回しやことばの使い分けができる。
- (4)比較的難度の高い文章を限られた時間内に理解し、要約、議論できる。
- (1) To be able to apply the Japanese skills you have acquired to your studies in your own major or field of research.
- (2) To be able to comprehend university lectures, read and write academic text, and participate in academic discussions with ease.
- (3) To be able to communicate with few grammatical errors, and to be able to distinguish and use expressions according to different situations.
- (4) To be able comprehend academic texts within a limited time, to be able to summarize and discuss.
