[授業の概要・目的]									
<p>In this class, students will explore globalization by examining the historical development and current state of the global automotive industry. Throughout the 20th century, the automotive industry shaped the core institutions of modern capitalist societies. Global car manufacturers, dealership networks, supply chains, labor relations, industrial and social policies, social classes, and international relations have all been profoundly influenced by this industry. Today, the industry is undergoing unprecedented changes, primarily in two areas: (1) electrification and digitalization, and (2) shifting geopolitics. This class aims to introduce students to these dimensions, helping them gain a deeper understanding of the foundations and dynamics of globalization.</p>									
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<p>This lecture aims to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of modern capitalist societies and the global structures they have shaped. The class is interdisciplinary, covering topics from political science, sociology, economics, and business history. Students will learn not only about the major actors in the automotive industry, but also about the differences and similarities among societies across regions - from East Asia to South America. Finally, students will develop skills to critically analyze the ongoing evolution of globalization, recognizing the automotive industry's central role in cultural, economic, and political global processes.</p>
