[授業の概要・目的]									
Sociology can be broadly defined as the scientific study of social interactions, social behaviors, and society. This field encompasses a range of subtopics - such as institutions, power, organizations, and social stratification - making sociology a complex and challenging discipline. This lecture introduces and discusses the main topics, theories, concepts, and key authors in sociology, providing students with the knowledge and tools to understand both the evolution of contemporary societies and the patterns of everyday human behavior.									
[到達目標]									
The objective of this course is to familiarize students with the main concepts of sociology, enabling them to understand and analyze the evolution of contemporary societies. Students will explore various dimensions of society through engagement with real-life sociological problems and discussion of numerous case studies, providing a broad introduction to the study of social behavior. By the end of the course, students will have acquired knowledge and analytical skills to deepen their understanding of social phenomena - both those that shape human behavior and those that emerge from it - and, for some, a foundation to pursue further studies in the social sciences at university.
