<p>The outbreak of the First World War violently transformed international relations and set the theme for the twentieth century. The fallout from this conflict created new and competing international orders which shaped modern history to the present. Many of the issues facing us today, such as war in Ukraine, conflict in the Middle East, and weaknesses in the international order can trace their origins to the First World War. The main purpose of this course is to help us understand the impact of war and violence in shaping modern history. The course will develop in four sections. Part 1 First World War, Part 2 the years from the First to Second World Wars, Part 3 will focus on the collapse of empire and decolonization and finally Part 4 will discuss war and conflict in the 21st Century.</p>
