【授業の概要・目的】									
<p>This course explores the intricate connections between sustainability and human activities. We will focus primarily on ecotourism and the hospitality industry, energy needs, and other areas of interest. We will examine how human activities impact the environment and how we can change what we so that our environment is protected. Students will gain a better understanding of how a more balanced society helps humans create better communities and countries. Specific examples of how to implement sustainable practices will be explored.</p>									
【到達目標】									
<p>The course will explore what sustainability is and how to put it into action. Topics will be interesting and relevant to everyone, including where our energy comes from and ways to improve our daily lives. The goal is to learn about interesting topics and have opportunities to interact in English and learn about different cultures. Students will have many opportunities in class for discussions and small group projects. This course is designed for any student in any discipline.</p>									
【授業計画と内容】									
<p>This is an intensive 1-week course that meets 3 times per day with 90 minutes lectures each. There will be a lunch break from 12:00#821113:00 1h. I will focus on the history of sustainability and how it has shaped our world today. We will examine why the concept of sustainability is critical in all human activities. A focus on the hospitality industry, including ecotourism, meeting the energy needs of society, and promoting a healthy environment are necessary. The course is designed to provide students a safe environment where they will feel comfortable participating in English no matter what level of English skills that they have. In-class activities will primarily be in small groups to discuss and research ideas presented in the lectures. If possible, short field trip will be arranged to explore natural areas near campus. Lectures will cover the following topics: a short history of "sustainability"; where we get our energy from and what improvements can be made in this area; sustainability actions in ecotourism and the hospitality industry; and how we can apply sustainability to our daily lives.</p>									
【履修要件】									
<p>This course is open to all students who have an interest in sustainability and want to learn in English. I think basic English skills are enough and will support those students in class using Google Translate or other Apps. There is no prior knowledge needed for this course and any reading material will be provided in class.</p>
